

P-6 Farms Homeschool Field Trip Guidelines 2019

Farm Hours: 9:30-1:30

We are thrilled you have booked a field trip at P-6 Farms this season and can't wait for your visit! In the meantime, **please share the following information** with your home-school group, students, and parents prior to your field trip.

Upon arrival:

The adult who made the reservations is to check in at the red ticket booth & pay for the entire group in 1 transaction. After he/she checks in, you will be given the number of bands for each person (3 years and up) in your group. As you are doing this, the remainder of your group is welcome to line up in the parking lot and wait for their bands.

Admission Price (3 years and up):

\$8 **TAX INCLUDED** (10 minimum paying admissions)

*children 3-18 will be given **4 tickets** to use at their discretion below*

Homeschool Trips require a confirmed reservation

Stationed Activities & Rules: (stations may change and/or not operated without notice & close at **1:00**)

1 ticket per activity. Height requirements posted on rides.

1. Cow Train - students must remain buckled during the ride & are to sit up while keeping hands and feet inside the car.

2. Apple Blaster - students must line up and wait until called, stand behind the fencing, and do not climb on the fencing. Parents are asked to help monitor students. **(5 years and under require parental assistance.)**

3. Jumping Pillow - no shoes (socks are optional). No flips, cartwheels, rolls, tag, etc. **Only jumping is allowed!!!**

4. Kiddie Whip - 1-2 persons per car (depending on size) and must remain sitting while the ride is moving.

5. Jeep Ride - 1-2 persons per car (depending on size) and must remain sitting while the ride is moving.

6. Roller Coaster - 1-2 persons per car (depending on size) and must remain sitting while the ride is moving.

*rides follow posted height requirements & some might NOT be able to ride. **DON'T ASK TO BEND THE RULE!**

*additional tickets may be purchased in the store for **\$1.00 ea**. Tickets are nonrefundable & lost tickets aren't replaced*

Maze - students & parents **only** have access to **Phase 1** (2 acre maze - takes roughly 15 minutes). **Children under 12 years MUST have an adult with them. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** Absolutely NO running, picking corn, throwing corn, and most importantly DO NOT CUT THROUGH (stay on the paths only)! If it is brought to our attention that children under 12 are unattended and/or individuals (children and/or adults) are cutting through the maze, **THEY WILL BE ESCORTED OUT & NOT ALLOWED BACK IN!!!**

Hayride - closes at **1:00**. Riders must sit on the hay bales & keep all body parts inside the trailer while moving.

Pig races - Only one show during the week, beginning at 12:00 (will announce if the time changes).

Allergies: If you have students who are allergic to hay, bees, etc... please bring their appropriate medicine.

Country Store: We sell a variety of drinks, candies, and toys etc. **Children are welcome in but ONLY with an adult.**

Food/Water: The concession stand will be open selling nachos & fountain drinks.

Activities CLOSE at 1:00 & the farm CLOSES at 1:30. Reminders of closing will be announced & are to be followed.

In case of inclement weather, please call the farm 936-597-6062 before departing to confirm that your field trip will take place on the scheduled day and time.

***GUESTS ARE TO FOLLOW ALL P-6 FARM'S RULES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AND AT EACH STATION. IF RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED, GUESTS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE ACTIVITY BY AN EMPLOYEE WITH CONSENT OF MANAGEMENT.**
